

Project Guide

Scatter Platter - bowl, dish, platter

Glass Cutting: **none required**

Firings: **full fuse, slump**



Step-by-Step

1. Select pieces of transparent glass and use nippers to create random shapes.
2. Spread some Klyr-fire on the clear Blank. This will allow you to reposition pieces as you assemble your design.
3. Beginning at the outer edge of your Blank, position pieces around the perimeter. (See Figure 1.)
4. Fill the center section with a single layer of pieces, randomly scattered.
5. Now add a second layer on top, overlapping pieces. Affix with pinpoints of glue if necessary. (See Figure 2.)
6. A third layer is optional. Your full-fused piece will be about 1/4" in thickness.
7. After fusing flat, slump into an appropriate mold.

Materials We Used

Blanks: 10" clear Round

Colors: 4-6 transparent colors

Note: This is a beautiful way to take advantage of the transparent character of glass by overlapping favorite colors to create new shades between them. Remember, colors get darker when they overlap, so use lighter colors initially.
