## Roller Points



### Narrow Rollers

Use with Ruler to create straight decorative embossed narrow lines for added interest. Or, use the Roller to decorate inside design areas.



### Medium Rollers

Use with Ruler to create straight decorative embossed medium lines for added interest. Or, use the Roller to decorate inside design areas.

## Nylon Points



### Nylon Detailer

Use to refine and detail Metal around embossed designs and to write, doodle, and trace designs.



### Nylon Universal

Use to refine and detail Metal around embossed designs and to smooth surface of metal.



### Nylon Rounded

Use to refine and detail Metal around embossed designs and to smooth inside/outside of large embossed areas.



### Nylon Roller Eraser

Use on a smooth, hard surface to smooth Metal and to erase unwanted marks or embossing.

## Ball & Cup Points



### Ball Point

Use to create a dome, circle, or dot with Metal on the Foam Mat. Flip Metal and use with Cup Point on hard surface to form a dome. Can also be used to emboss larger curved or rounded designs.



### Cup Point

Use on a hard surface to define a dome, circle or dot made with the Ball Point. Flip the Metal over and place Cup Point over the impression previously made with the Ball Point and apply pressure to emboss.

## Additional Points



### Burnishing Brush

Use to create a matte finish on Metal. Add texture by using a circular, up/down, or back/forth motion, depending upon desired outcome.



### Metal Detailer

Use to write, doodle, create holes, and trace designs.



### Metal Stamps

Use to emboss Metal with design shapes. Place Point on Metal and create impression by rocking Point back and forth.

## Mats



### Foam Mat

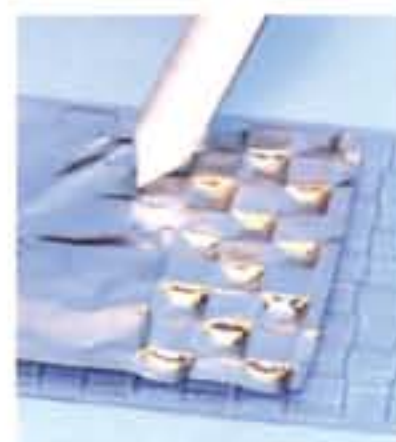
Use Foam Mat under Metal for deep impressions or embossing made with Rollers, Stamps, or Points.



### Acrylic Mat

Use Acrylic Mat under Metal to refine, detail, or erase mistakes made with Rollers, Stamps, or Points.

## Design Tools



### Design Sheets & Borders

Use for embossing on Metals. Place Design Tool under metal. Use Texture Tool to rub over Metal to expose design details.



### Texture Tool

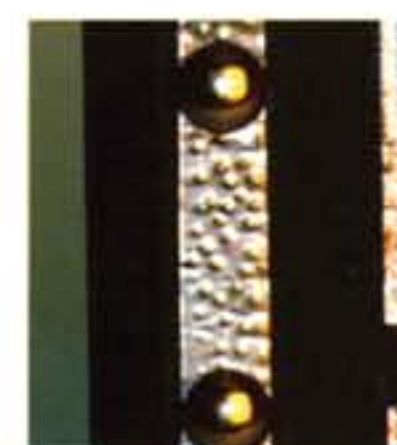
Use with metals that have been placed on top of Design Sheets or Borders. Use Texture Tool by rubbing over Metals to expose design details. Use to lightly smooth out edges or flatten out metal when starting.

## Tape/Tacks



### Metal Tape

Use to adhere metal to design surfaces.



### Metal Tacks

Use to attach metal pieces to wood.
