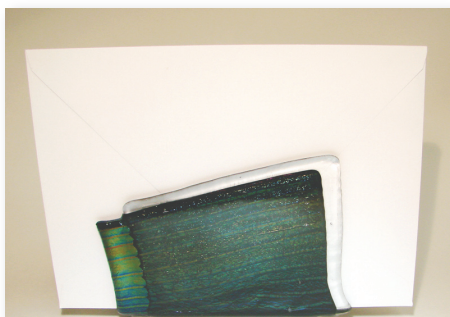
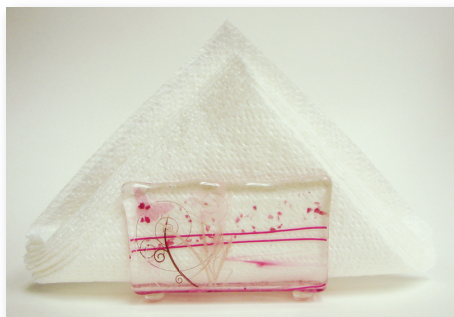


Anything Holder Kit

Keep business cards, napkins or mail in order with style.



- While wearing safety glasses, cut and prepare glass for your project. Some fun options include:
 - Using a circle or an oval as the base glass
 - Using a factory edge or cutting a wavy edge
 - Using scraps of compatible glass to create accents

*Note: Included 4" x 5" pieces are ideal for business card holders.
Use compatible glass up to 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" for additional design options.*
- Apply shelf wash (following manufacturer instructions) or cut shelf paper to fit shelf. Working on the prepared shelf, select a glass piece to use as a base for your project. Add additional layers or accents as desired.

Note: When heated, glass naturally wants to be 1/4" thick. If your stacked glass is less than 1/4" thick, the glass will shrink to become approximately 1/4" thick, if it is more than 1/4" thick it will spread out. Use any combination of glass layers to achieve 1/4" thickness, such as 2 pieces of standard glass, 1 standard and 2 thins, 4 thins, etc.
- Place the shelf into the room temperature kiln and fuse. (See chart below.)
- Once cooled, remove the fused glass from the kiln and rinse clean. Apply desired Fuse Art Decal following package instructions and allow to dry.
- Cut 3 pieces of shelf paper, approximately 9" x 5" each.
- Place mold on prepared kiln shelf. Center layers of shelf paper on mold, then position fused glass on mold and slump. (See chart below.)

Firing Schedules:			
Program	Rate	Temp	Hold
Fuse	300° F	1000° F	10 minutes
	300° F	1450° F	10 minutes
	FULL	960° F	20 minutes
Slump	300° F	1000° F	10 minutes
	300° F	1325° F	10 minutes
	FULL	960° F	20 minutes

NOTE: Firing times and temperatures may vary, each kiln is unique.
