



Soldered Art Gift Tags

Charming vintage appeal abounds with this simple gift tag. Frame favorite art, holiday greetings or photos for cherished keepsakes.

Materials:

Fancy Corner Filligree #87218

Lead Free Solder

Copper Foil

Flux

2" x 3" Rectangle Pre-Cut Micro-Thin Glass #87202

1-1/2" Circle Pre-Cut Micro-Thin Glass #87225

Jump Rings #70499

Instructions:

1. Trace pre-cut glass outline onto images, cut images to fit
2. Position images between 2 pieces of micro-thin glass. Delphi Tip: Use 2 images to make a double sided gift tag
3. Wrap the edges with copper foil tape and burnish smooth
4. Apply flux and solder the edges, building up a small solder bead
5. Add embellishments and jump rings as desired to link pieces and hang the project

Additional Ideas:

- Use boldly colored ribbon to attach the gift tag, it can serve as a pretty hanger to display the tag as an ornament also
- Incorporate pretty beads or festive bells into the project by attaching them on jump rings or head pins
- Consider adding etched details to the micro thin glass before creating the gift tag for another layer interest
- Overlap multiple images to create unique and fanciful scenes
