

# Fairy Princess Garden Stake

## Materials:

#B001330 White Opal – 1 Medium

#B042130 Pink Opal – 1 Small

#B113782 Amber Medium Frit

#B010088 Black Opal Powder Frit

#B012488 Red Opal Powder Frit

#94213 Magenta/Green on Black Dichroic

#40222 Rosie Garden Stake

Optional: #40900 Liquid Stringer Medium or #B8234 Glastac

## Instructions:

1. Measure opening in garden stake for overall project dimensions (approximately 7-1/2" diameter) and size pattern (below) to fit.
2. Cut White Opal glass to fit garden stake opening.
3. Cut 2 Pink Opal circles to make rosy cheeks.
4. Cut 2 Dichroic glass circles to form eyes.
5. Clean all glass pieces.
6. Place white glass on a prepared kiln shelf.
7. Using pattern for reference, position pink circles as cheeks and dichroic circles as eyes. Note: A small drop of Glastac can be used to secure pieces.
8. Apply Amber frit to an almond shaped area at the top of the panel.
9. Optional Step: Mix black powder frit with liquid stringer medium.
10. Apply a narrow border of black frit along the amber frit. Decorate with chips of scrap dichroic, 90 COE millefiori or colorful glass.
11. Use black frit to add eyelash lines and pupils to eyes, detail the nose, mouth and chin.
12. Optional Step: Mix red opal powder frit with liquid stringer medium.
13. Create lips with red frit.
14. Fire to a tack fuse to medium fuse.
15. Clean the fused face and install in garden stake using clear silicone adhesive.





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
