

# Fused Glass Ornaments

Make keepsake ornaments for everyone on your holiday list and spread some cheer.

## Materials:

Pre-Cut Fusible Glass Shapes – shown here:

System 96® Aventurine Evergreen CutUp™ #XCU41

Delphi 96 COE Gingerbread Pre-Cut #X23902

Dichroic Waves (optional) #X24671 shown

White Glassline Pen (optional) #802001 shown

Diamond Drill Bit #76411

## Instructions:

1. Clean pre-cut glass shapes
2. For Gingerbread Men, add Glassline accents and allow to dry
3. For Christmas Trees, cut Dichroic Waves to form garlands and ornaments and place on tree
4. Fire ornaments on a prepared kiln shelf
5. Place fired ornaments on top of a piece of scrap glass in a shallow dish and fill with cool water until just level with ornament surface
6. Using a rotary tool or household drill and the Diamond Drill Bit, drill a hole at the top of each ornament, allowing water to cool and flush the bit as you drill
7. Clean and hang ornaments

## Additional Design Ideas:

- Create unconventional ornaments with other pre-cut shapes
- Use Glassline Pens or Fusing Photo Paper to add a monogram or personal message to ornaments
- Join pre-cut shapes together to make wreathes, or add them to plates or other décor
