

Making Your Own Dots

You can make your own dots from the left over pieces of glass. There are hundreds of uses for dots, so make lots!

Materials:

Random pieces of glass – tiny to small

ThinFire Shelf Paper

Studio Prep Instructions:

1. Line the kiln shelf with ThinFire Shelf Paper.
2. Place chips of glass close together on the shelf.
3. Full Fuse.



Tips and Tricks:

- Need perfect Dots? Cut ½” square chips of glass and then fire. These will form perfect dots every time!
- Make eyeballs for kid’s projects. Stack a small square or rectangle piece with a couple of layers of glass, and fire to a full fuse.
- Use Millefiori for fun flower centers
- Make hair pins, bracelets and much more!
