

Fused Wreath

Create a fused glass seasonal wreath to hang as an ornament or as holiday decorations. This project is a great way to utilize scrap glass.

Materials:

Aventurine Green #B111230

Fern Green #U60-753

Vanilla, White Mardi Gras #B4237F

Happy Holiday Fusible Dots Assortment #94700

Silver Plated Filigree Bails #91801

Glass adhesive

Instructions:

1. Clean glass thoroughly removing any residue.
2. Cut or nip tested compatible pieces into triangles, squares or rectangles depending on the desired results.
3. Arrange pieces making sure they are overlapped on a kiln shelf lined with shelf paper.
4. Add decorative embellishments such as dots or other accessory glass.
5. Fire to a tack fuse. See firing schedule below.
6. Once fired clean shelf paper off the back side of the wreath.
7. Apply bail using glass adhesive.



Tack Fuse

Ramp Temp	Temperature	Hold Time
300°	1000°	5 minutes
300°	1375°	5 minutes
9999	900°	20 minutes



Note: All kilns are not alike. Your kiln size, controller type, and individual project may require some alteration to this schedule for best results.
